Our Offer

The Lyric Hammersmith Theatre is seeking a new Digital Partner. An organisation or individual to join our existing partnership programme. The partnership collectively delivers over one hundred high quality after school and holiday classes each year for young people in West London. We provide over 2,000 free or low cost spaces for young people to participate in drama, dance, music and multi arts, to help develop their creative, social, personal and economic potential.

We are now seeking a Digital Partner to join our existing partnership from September 2022 by providing weekly classes during term time at the Lyric for the next generation of young people who wish to develop their digital skillset. This could include filmmaking, editing, animation, coding, projection, broadcasting, podcasts, graphic design, video game design or other digital art forms.

We are open to receiving applications from start-ups, individuals and organisations who can demonstrate a commitment and track record of working with young people digitally.



Partnership Benefits

- Low cost space to deliver classes for young people as part of the partnership programme. (£31 for 2.5 hours on weekdays or 3.5 hours on weekends)
- Reduced hire cost to deliver additional activities (subject to availability)
- Support from a designated Young Lyric Host to welcome and support young people attending partnership programme classes and activities
- Marketing and promotion of the partnership programme and classes

- Box Office services, including online booking facilities for all classes
- The opportunity to base your administration offices at the Lyric through affordable desk use in the designated partner office.
- Bursary funds to cover the full cost of two places per class
- Access to our partnership training programme
- Staff discount at the Lyric Bar (20%) and Outsider Tart Café (15%)
- Theatre ticket offers including invites to Lyric press night performances



Partnership Commitments

- Offer a year round programme of affordable after-school or weekend activities at the Lyric as part of the partnership programme for young people aged between 0-25 who live in West London*
- Ensure all delivery staff are employed subject to an enhanced DBS check
- Deliver activities on a 1:12 ratio of practitioner to participant to ensure best practice and uphold high quality engagement
- Work towards end of term sharing's for classes
- Uphold the Lyric's safeguarding policy

- Use the Lyric Box Office to enable a centralised membership, booking and data collection service, unless otherwise agreed
- Attend four strategic partnership meetings each year
- Provide any specialist equipment required for activities
- Demonstrate an understanding and commitment towards Diversity and Inclusion
- Ensure the contracted delivery team (defined as practitioners, assistants and visiting artists) are representative of our West London community



The Recording

Recording Control Room

Our recording studio is built around an Apple Mac Pro running Logic Pro X, although we have other software available, and through a Solid State Audio Nucleus digital console. We have a large live room with 32 analogue channels connected straight back to our control room, which has a large window between the two spaces.

The control room has sound, video and network connections to most rooms in the building including both theatres, the cinema, film and tv studio and the film edit suite. We hold a collection of microphones and have a small vocal booth set up within the live room as standard.



The Cinema

Our intimate 55-seat state of the art cinema includes a 2k projector with 7.1 surround sound and a native 16:9 projection surface. The cinema is also equipped with a small lighting rig to help facilitate presentations, meetings, lectures and small performances.




Video Edit Suite

The video edit suite sits at the heart of the Ruben Foundation Wing and is a hub of interconnectivity, with facilities panels that connect to our Film & TV Studio, Recording Studio and Cinema. The Video Edit Suite benefits from an Apple Mac Pro (2013) with Final Cut Pro X installed, along with two retina displays.



The digital playspace includes a large touch screen display for presentations; the walls are lined with TV monitors with multiple connectivity ports below the monitors. The room has WiFi access, power outlets and Ethernet ports around the walls and in the floor allowing capacity for participants to plug in, and use various devices.





Music Practice Rooms

All three music practice rooms benefit from perforated wooden acoustic panelling with a high degree of absorption to help control unwanted noise. Music practice rooms one and two are the perfect size for one-one instrument or vocal classes. Music Practice room three is big enough to hold a small ensemble or a choir and is served by facilities panels which connect

to the recording studio allowing the room to be used as a secondary live room for the recording studio. Music practice room three is situated adjacent to the Music Store allowing quick access to instruments, music stands and other auxiliary equipment. Permanently installed on the celling of Music Practice Room three is a HD 2000 lumens projector.
