About The Play




Jack & The Beanstalk is a Play.

This is a story told by many people on stage.



There are songs in the play that the characters will be singing.

These songs might be quite loud.



Sometimes the characters will talk to the audience and ask the audience questions.

When the characters do this then you are allowed answer and join in.



This Play is a Pantomime which means it has a lot of jokes and silliness.

Characters

Jack is the hero of the story! Jack is outspoken, brave, ambitious but a little bit greedy
Jill is Jack's best friend. Jill is very kind and caring. Jill is in training to be a Fairy Godmother.
Simon is Jack's brother. Simon always like to try new things but those things often go wrong
Dame Trott is Jack & Simon's Mum. Dame Trott is played by a man dressed as a woman. Dame Trott owns a milking business called Trott's World of Milk.
Fleshcreep is the villain of the story. Fleshcreep is played by a woman dressed as a man. He is a bad man! The audience will say 'BOOOO' when he comes on stage.



Daisy is a Cow. She belongs to Jack, Simon and Dame Trott.











There are 4 Ensemble members.

They play all the other parts such as the people of Hammersmith, the Fleshcreepettes, the Work Experience People, a Ghost, the Simon Show Assistants and lots more!

SCENE 1 – FAIRY SCHOOL



Jill and the other fairies are about to do their final exam so they can graduate from fairy school.



The fairies have to choose who they would like to be Fairy Godmother to.







Jill wants to be **Jack**'s fairy godmother.

Jill will only be able to be a full Fairy
Godmother if Jack's wishes
make the world better.



Jack comes on stage.

Jack and **Jill** say 'hello' to the audience. The audience can say 'hello' back if they want.





Jack is angry about all the trouble and unfairness in the world.





Jack wishes for a sausage roll to cheer her up.

Jill and the audience magic **Jack** a sausage roll. The audience can join in the wishing!

SCENE 2 – HAMMERSMITH BROADWAY







Jack and Jill sing about how nothing is going to break the soul of the people of Hammersmith.





Simon enters and sings about how he is **Jack**'s younger brother and about how great **Jack** is.







Dame Trott enters and sings about the amazing milk she sells.



Dame Trott introduces **Daisy the Cow**.



The song ends and **Dame Trott** says 'hello' to the audience.

The audience can say 'hello' back!





There is a huge rumble and the claw of **The Evil Giant** snatches
The Butcher's Sheep. It's a bit scary!





Fleshcreep enters and tells everyone his greedy Giant Tax is due tomorrow.



Jack and Fleshcreep have an argument.

Fleshcreep tries to snatch

Jack with The Evil Giant's claw.

Dame Trott stops him!



Dame Trott and Fleshcreep have a romantic moment.
Then they snap out of it.

SCENE 3 – THE SIMON SHOW





Simon comes on to do The Simon Show!

The Assistants sing a silly song about The Simon Show.



Simon tries to skate-board but he crashes.





Dame Trott is upset because her business, not doing well.





To try and help the business **Dame Trott** picks a Business Partner from the audience to help her run Trott's World of Milk.

She'll ask the audience to sing a song to decide.

SCENE 4 – TROTT'S WORLD OF MILK








Fleshcreep wants to steal **Daisy the Cow** to ride her around Hammersmith.

Jack and Jill interrupt Fleshcreep before he can steal Daisy the Cow.





It's time to milk **Daisy the Cow** in **Dame Trott's** new Milking Machine.





The Milking Machine breaks and **Dame Trott** goes inside to try and fix it.



Dame Trott gets stuck in the machine and gets covered in milk!

SCENE 5 – THE SIMON SHOW





Simon tries to do an escape trick.

He fails!

SCENE 6 – TROTT'S WORLD OF MILK





Dame Trott is upset because they don't have any money to pay Fleshcreep's Giant Tax.





Dame Trott decides they need to sell Daisy the Cow to pay for the Giant Tax.





how sad she is that

Daisy the Cow has to be sold.

SCENE 7 – ON THE WAY TO MARKET







how rich she might be if she sells **Daisy the Cow**.







Fleshcreep disguises himself as Creshfleep to trick Jack into selling Daisy the Cow to him.







Fleshcreep (in disguise) tricks Jack into selling **Daisy the Cow** for some 'Magic' Beans which aren't really Magic.

SCENE 8 – HAMMERSMITH BROADWAY






Jill talks to the audience about her dreams of making the world a better place and making **Fleshcreep** go away. Jill wishes on a shooting star!





Jack comes back with the beans and realises she has been tricked by Fleshcreep.



INTERVAL

There will be a 20 minute break where the audience can go to the toilet, get a drink or an ice cream


SCENE 1 – GIANT-LAND







Fleshcreep and his robot assistants called "The Fleshcreepettes" sing a song about how great **Fleshcreep** is.



Fleshcreep lists all the things he has in Giant-land, including a Magic Goose who lays golden eggs.







Simon, Dame Trott, Jack and Jill climb into Giant-land.







Simon pushes a button which then opens a lift.

They all go into the lift to try and find Daisy the Cow.

SCENE 2 – THE LIFT





The lift is haunted by a **Ghost**.







Simon, Dame Trott, Jack and Jill sing a song to make it less scary.







The **Ghost** captures

Jill, **Dame Trott** and **Simon**.

SCENE 3 – THE LIVESTOCK ROOM



The Fleshcreepettes have captured
Simon, Jill and Dame Trott.
They are trapped in the Livestock Room.



They find **Daisy the Cow** in the Livestock Room.


SCENE 4 – THE TREASURE ROOM







Jack finds herself in the Treasure Room! She is very excited by all the gold.





Jack finds the Magic Goose. She works out that the Goose lays golden eggs when you say the password 'Goosey Goosey Go!'





Jack also finds a magic harp that plays beautiful music.

SCENE 5 – THE LIVESTOCK ROOM





Jill hopes that **Jack** will come and rescue them all.

Fleshcreep mocks Jill –
he tells Jill that Jack is not coming
to save them. Jill is sad.

SCENE 5 – THE LIVESTOCK ROOM & THE TREASURE ROOM













Everyone sings a big song about how they are feeling.

Jack wants to be a hero and rich.

Jill wants Jack to stop being selfish and rescue them.

Dame Trott and **Fleshcreep** are confused whether or not they love each other.

Simon wants to escape!

None of them want to be alone.

SCENE 6 – A GAME!





Dame Trott decides it is time for a break from the show.

Dame Trott chooses two audience members to play The Annual Trott's World of Milk Milkshake Shake Up.

SCENE 7 – THE LIVESTOCK ROOM





Jack finds Jill, Simon and Dame Trott in the Livestock Room.

Jack shows everyone the treasure she's found.



Jack and Jill have an argument.

Jill says **Jack** is selfish for stealing the Magic Goose so she can be rich.





Simon plays the Harp and it makes a horrible noise because it's been stolen.





Fleshcreep hears the alarm and enters.

Jack tells Fleshcreep that he is a horrible man and they are not going to be pushed around by him anymore.










Fleshcreep tells the **Giant** to eat them all.



The **Giant** is about to eat **Jill** but **Jack** jumps in front to save her.



SCENE 8 – FRONT OF STAGE









Jack, Jill and Simon celebrate defeating the **Giant** by singing a song.

> The audience can join in with the chorus of the song.





Jill is made a full Fairy Godmother because the world is a better place through Jack's wishes.

SCENE 9 – THE WEDDING



Everyone sings a song about how grateful they are for one another and how everything turned out okay in the end.

> The audience is asked to join in with a dancing spell!



The Play is finished.

All the actors bow and the audience will clap.
