



DRACULA CONTENT WARNINGS

Morgan Lloyd Malcolm's *Dracula*, based on the novel by Bram Stoker, contains themes and scenes that may impact some audience members. Details are outlined below – **please note the following does contain plot spoilers.**

Our content warnings evolve as the production does so there may be changes made to this document between booking and attending your performance. Please check back ahead of your visit for further updates.

The play contains scenes of violence and specifically gender-based violence: there are allusions to sexual assault, including scenes in which a woman lying on a bed is attacked by a man from above. The play contains multiple references to death (including of children); abduction; blood; the use of weapons and reference to hanging. The play explores themes of trauma and grief throughout.

This production is most suitable for ages 13+. Under 14s must be accompanied by a full paying adult. It remains the responsibility of the accompanying adult to judge the suitability of the show for children in advance of purchase.
