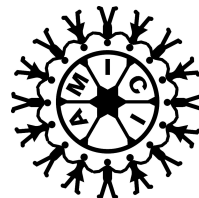


Amici Dance Theatre Company – Our Time

Visual Guide

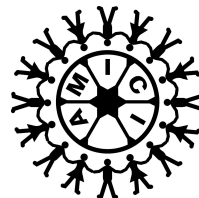




Our Time is a new show taking place at Lyric Hammersmith Theatre.

The performance will last for 85 minutes.

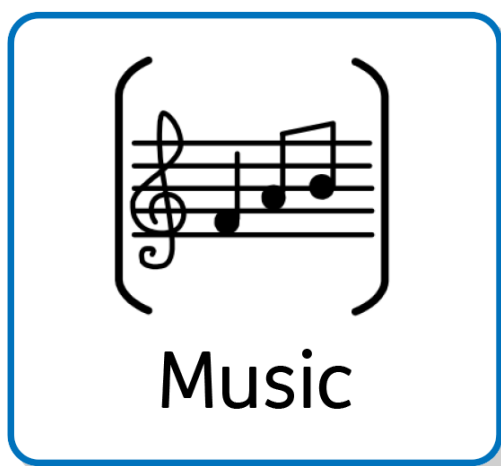


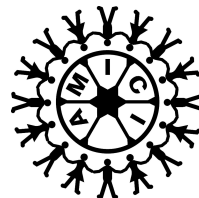


- The show will tell a story with dance.

About the Show



Overture:

The full company is on stage. There are lots of dancers, and some of them use wheelchairs.

Two young men – Wolfgang and George – dance together.



Scene 1:

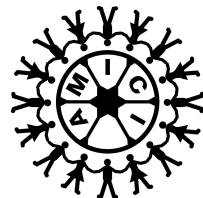
There is a loud clap of thunder and umbrellas go up.

There is rain in the park.
The sun comes out.
George and Wolf meet.



Scene 2:

This scene is set in Sri Lanka. People arrive on the beach and the dancers make a fishing boat. There is a dance with women wearing scarves. Wolfgang takes part in the dance, and George is happy to see this.



Scene 3:

This scene is set in Berlin. Two groups of people are separated by a wall. They wave at each other, and throw parcels. Guards with batons keep them apart. Wolfgang and George are sad to see this.



Scene 4:

This scene is set in London. Wolfgang and George move into a flat together.

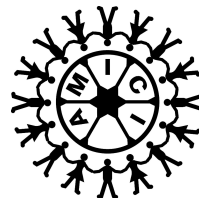
Wolfgang starts teaching a dance class, while George is sketching a man.

Wolfgang comes home and is angry when he sees George and the man.

Next, Wolfgang and George go to the ballet.

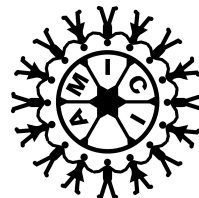
Two dancers do a beautiful duet.

After this, Wolfgang and George go back to their flat and throw a big party. At the end, they hear on the radio that the wall in Berlin is going to be removed.

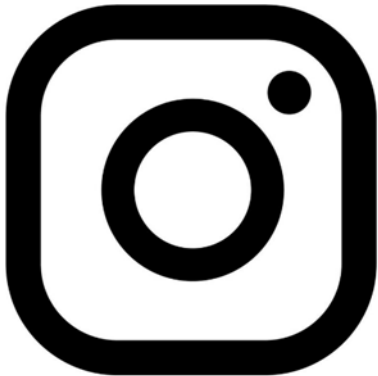
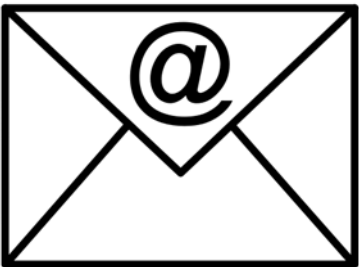


	Scene 5: This scene is set back in Berlin. The wall comes down. Families are reunited and there is a big celebration.
	Scene 6: This scene is set in London. There are lots of different groups protesting. One of the groups is a gay pride group, and one of the performers sings a song.
	Scene 7: This scene is set in Sri Lanka. There are guards walking threateningly around the dancers. There is a big wave – a tsunami – which causes a lot of destruction.
	Scene 8: This scene is back in London. George says goodbye to Wolfgang, and he dies. Everybody dances together, then, Wolfgang waves goodbye and leaves the stage. Everyone dances together again.
